Join us for a fun-filled Nature Day on June 15 from 10-11:30 a.m. in Ken-Caryl's open space! The Open Space Committee and Ken-Caryl Ranch Rangers would like to invite the community to a morning of learning and exploring in our open space. Participants will meet at the Bradford firepit, near the Braford Perley House in The Valley, and can participate in a short, guided hike, a nature scavenger hunt, wildlife education, crafts, historical tour and a visit from a live raptor (courtesy of the Raptor Education Foundation). 
