
# Ken-Caryl Ranch Master Association Community Recycling Survey - COMING SOON!



The Master Association Board voted at its October 2023 meeting to switch to bi-weekly recycling. Three out of the five board members voted to transition to a bi-weekly recycling schedule for an approximate savings of \$89k/year.

On May 1, Ken-Caryl Ranch officially adopted a bi-weekly recycling schedule. The Master Association and its Board are interested in getting community input on this new schedule and additional insight on recycling collection services moving forward. Please

## District Board Contemplating Mill Levy Ballot Initiative



Your local park and recreation provider, the Ken-Caryl Ranch Metropolitan District, receives 14% of your total property tax bill for general operating and another 3% for the bond repayment mill, totaling 17%. The bond repayment mill began in 2014 and is set to end in December 2024. As a potential capital funding option, the District's Board could place a ballot initiative on the November 2024 ballot asking voters to approve converting a portion of the bond mill

levy as a general operating mill levy designated for capital and maintenance projects. The Board will be discussing potential ballot language options at its June 25 meeting at 6 p.m. at the Ranch House and via Zoom. Please click on the button below to view this meeting's agenda and access options.




